Of the [17 Sustainable Development Goals \(SDGs\)](#) that were defined at the time, below are the 14 SDGs on which Sucafina and its partners can have an impact within the coffee supply chain:



## ELIMINATE POVERTY

- By pursuing farmers' prosperity, productivity growth, and improving access to finance, which increases the capacity of farmers to grow their businesses.
- By improving traceability and moving towards a more equitable distribution of coffee income throughout the value chain.



## ERASE HUNGER

- By opening discount retail stores, we are improving farmers living income in our CWS (Rwanda, Burundi).
- By providing farmers with seeds for Food Security during the COVID-19 crisis in East Africa.



## PROVIDE QUALITY EDUCATION

- By improving farmers' skills on Agricultural Practices, technology, business management, etc.
- By improving school classes in Rwanda, and increasing the access to education.



## ENFORCE GENDER EQUALITY

- By working on women empowerment in Burundi and creating women's cooperatives in Rwanda.
- By training households as a whole and including women in the businesses for increased representation of women within the coffee value chain.
- By sourcing Women's coffee in Peru and Colombia, above market price.




## IMPROVE CLEAN WATER AND SANITATION

- By adopting water conservation practices, in terms of quality and quantity, at our coffee washing stations to improve the water use efficiency.
- By improving wastewater treatment.



## ENSURE ACCESS TO AFFORDABLE, RELIABLE, SUSTAINABLE ENERGY FOR ALL

- By increasing energy efficiency and adopting renewable energy in some of our mills in East Africa.



## CREATE DECENT WORK AND ECONOMIC GROWTH

- By increasing the adoption of improved labor practices on farms (wage/living income, workers' rights, Health & Safety).



## INCREASE INDUSTRY, INNOVATION, AND INFRASTRUCTURE

- By focusing on innovation to boost data collection and reliability, increasing the number of farms covered by a mobile network, and allowing them to communicate and access information more easily.



## REDUCE INEQUALITY

- By growing more prosperous and resilient farmers with our "Farmer Hub" initiative, and pursuing Shared Value.



## BUILD SUSTAINABLE CITIES AND COMMUNITIES

- By building and renovating schools in Rwanda to provide a safe learning environment.



## INFLUENCE RESPONSIBLE CONSUMPTION AND PRODUCTION

- By promoting climate-smart agricultural techniques, improving farmers' resilience and profitability, increasing purchases of sustainable coffee, and ensuring premium prices received by producers.



## ORGANIZE CLIMATE ACTION

- By measuring our greenhouse gas emissions in our supply chain in Rwanda and in some of our offices.
- By training farmers on climate-smart practices.



## ADVANCE LIFE ON LAND

- By monitoring the land use and adopting soil conservation practices.



## BUILD PARTNERSHIPS FOR THE GOALS

- By collaborating with so many partners in the private and public sectors.
